Worsley Suffers Malady

MONTREAL (CP) — Montreal Canadiens' star goalie Lorne (Gump) Worsley told the Canadian Press Saturday he has been suffering chest and back pains which have been getting progressively worse since last Wednesday. "The docs don't know what's wrong," he said in a telephone interview from his nearby Beloeil, Que., home. He said x-rays were taken Saturday morning at Montreal General Hospital, after various other tests Thursday. "I can't keep anything down. If I have a cup of coffee I leave it in no time," said Gump. "I haven't been sleeping well, catnapping since the pain started. I wish they could prescribe something, even if only sleeping pills. But they can't because they don't know what the trouble is." 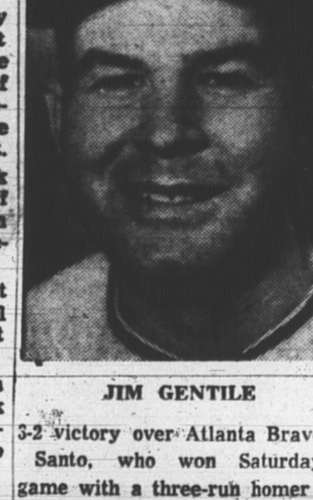

New York Beat Dodgers; Giants Squeak By Phils

LOS ANGELES (AP)—Pinch-hitter Bob Taylor, doubled in two runs and scored on Roy McMillan's single in the ninth inning as New York Mets edged Los Angeles Dodgers 7-6 Sunday and snapped the Dodgers' winning streak at five games. The Mets' three-run rally wiped out a three-run outburst in the eighth inning that gave the Dodgers a 6-4 lead. Two of the runs came on Jim Leveaux's second homer of the game, an inside-the-park blast. But the Mets came right back in the ninth. Cleon Jones led off with a single, and after Ron Perranoski replaced Phil Regan, Dick Stuart walked. Ken Boyer struck out, but Taylor batted for Ed Kranepok and lined a double into the left field corner, tying the game. After walking Ron Swoboda intentionally, Perranoski struck out Jerry Grote. However, McMillan followed with a single to left, driving in Taylor.



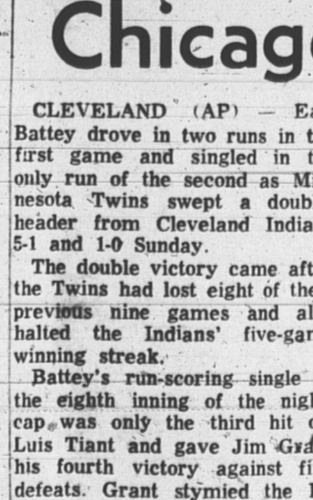
