MONTREAL (CP) - Cattle receipts were mostly mixed qualities and prices for all classes were steady Monday on Montreal livestock markets. Demand good and trading active. Receipts: 138 cattle, 188 calves, 5 hogs, 10 sheep and lambs.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) - Cam Mines Ltd. caught fire in the late stages of trading on the Toronto Stock Exchange Tuesday as it jumped 66 cents to 1.00 on 613,490 shares.

The company is reported to have encountered mineralization on its Highland Valley property in British Columbia but no assays have been reported. Prices sagged in other market activity with "base" metals suffering the largest decline.

TORONTO (CP) - Improved conditions steadied prices on a broader demand for all classes and grades of slaughter cattle at the Ontario Public Stockyards Tuesday.

Veal calf prices were actively higher, hogs higher and lambs steady to higher. Slaughter cattle 3,350: Choice steers 26-27 with sales to 28; good 25-26; mediums 23-25; and commons 20-22.

NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) - Depressed by a Washington warning that prices and profits may be getting too high for the health of the economy, the stock market took one of its worst losses of the year Tuesday, bringing the level down to its lowest of 1966.

DIVIDEND LOWER

Another factor in the decline was the disappointing dividend action by General Motors Monday. The payout will bring half-year payments to \$2.20 instead of \$2.25 in the first half of 1965.
