LONDON, May 22.—Thousands of old Barnardo boys in Canada will hear with interest that Dr. Barnardo's Home at St. Stepney Causeway, London E., has been transported to country surroundings. The headquarters for 50 years have been in the East End of London. A few days ago all the boys left for new quarters in Hertfordshire. They will live in future on a beautiful country estate at Goldings, in a spacious mansion built in 1870. The estate, which is near Hertford, was purchased to form a memorial to the late Mr. W. Baker, who was honorary director from 1905 to 1920. The offices for Dr. Barnardo's Homes will remain at Stepney.

"Day Of Miracles" Witnessed In Rome

ROME, May 19.—This has been a "day of miracles" in Rome. For the first time in the city centuries, faith-healing was demonstrated here by James Hickson, at the American Episcopal Church. Mr. Hickson, a layman of the Church of England has healed by faith many of the ill and lame in England and America.

Crowds gathered outside the church. The lame, the halt and the blind, formed in line and took their turns in passing by Mr Hickson. Some could not walk and were in wheel chairs. Others were crippled and limped on crutches. Many of the visitors seemed to be persons of means, for they drove up in automobiles. The faith-healer laid his hands on each sufferer and offered a brief prayer. A clergyman followed Mr Hickson in giving his blessing to each afflicted man, woman and child, and, with the hands on the head of each, said: "God bless you and complete the healing which is begun in you this day." The faith displayed rather astonished Mr Hickson, accustomed as he is to such a demonstration. He was greatly impressed by the genuine emotion manifested by those in the crowd. Some were almost hysterical, weeping loudly and pearly fainting. All displayed most hopeful expectancy, which further assured Mr Hickson that his practice in Rome, the centre of the most powerful church in existence, will be crowned with success. One man, who had said he was blind, exclaimed after Mr Hickson's healing touch: "I can see." Several who walked into the church leaning on crutches walked out unassisted. In every case Mr Hickson emphasized in his prayer that he could heal only by the faith that God can heal.

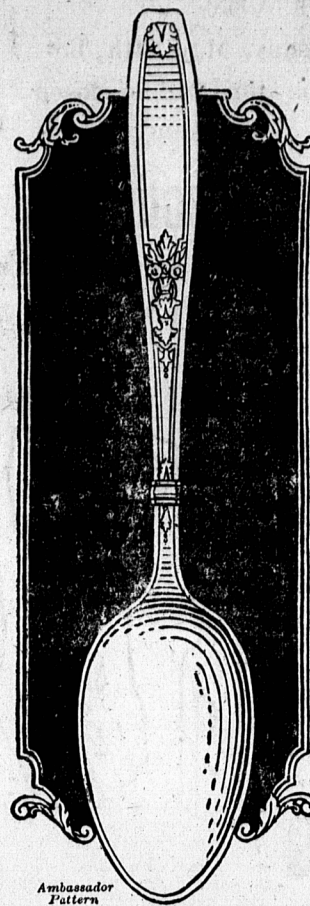
TO IMPROVE PORT OF SOUTHAMPTON

LONDON, May 19.—With the object of making Southampton one of the finest ports in the world the London and Southwestern Railway Co. has submitted to the Southampton corporation plans for reconstruction. The plans include a two mile line of piers resembling those at New York, several dry docks and the reclamation of 640 acres of mud land. The cost is estimated at several million pounds sterling, and it will take two years to complete the improvements.
