A Diphtheria Scare.

There is no doubt but that diphtheria in its worst form is very prevalent in many cities and small towns. At the same time; that fact is no reason for frightening people out of their wits, with every new case of sore throat.

"Putrid sore throat" is known long before diphtheria, was probably a form of diphtheria, and very dangerous. The tongue is coated, the throat and tonsils inflamed, little white spots, which increase and turn to a dirty yellow or brown color next appear, and a peculiar odor totally unlike ulcerated sore throat is noticeable.
