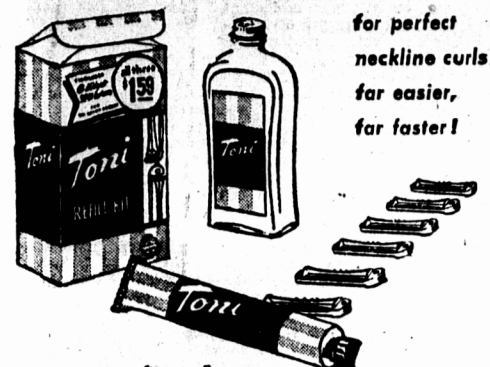

WOULD IGNORE RED DEAN - AUCKLAND, N. Z. May 22 - (AP) - The head of the Church of England has advised Anglican Churches throughout the world to ignore visits of the Dean of Canterbury, Dr. Howlett Johnson, Mayor John C. Allum said today he wrote recently to Dr. Geoffrey Fisher, Archbishop of Canterbury, asking him to define the position of the Church of England toward the so-called "Red Dean" so the city authorities would know the Church stood with regard to any visit Dr. Johnson might make here. "My advice to Anglican Churches overseas," the Archbishop replied, "is they should completely ignore a visit of Dean Canterbury..."
