Federated Petroleum Ltd., an independent Calgary firm, has announced acquisition of 400,000 acres of freehold and government leases in the three U. S. states. The company said it plans a program of exploration which, coupled with costs of leases, will entail more than \$1,000,000.

Bank Report Reviews

Nation's Economy. MONTREAL, Nov. 26 — The "rapidly mounting requirements of defence will enter the economic stream along with the equally important demands of a vigorous and growing program of resource development". The Bank of Montreal emphasizes this fact in its current Business Review, analyzing the impact on the nation's economy of the defence program, of expansion in resources development, and of the soon-to-come universal old age pensions.

For the first half of the fiscal year, states the report, the Government announced a budgetary surplus of \$513 millions, "an apparent windfall which has not gone unnoticed by a tax-conscious Canadian public". The big departure from original estimates was on the expenditure side, with only \$470 millions, or 27 per cent of the \$1,729 million appropriated for defence spent in the half year ended September 30.

"But the rate of rearmament outlays has recently been rising rapidly and should continue to accelerate in the months immediately ahead," says the B. of M. In mid-October, the report continues, the Minister of Defence Production forecast that, before another year is out, disbursements for construction and procurement "may approach an average of \$125 millions a month". Defence orders have "naturally tended to run well ahead of outlays for deliveries and progress payments."

Resource Development. The review emphasizes that Canada's contribution to defence cannot be measured in terms of military expenditures alone. These go hand in hand with development of strategic resources. The value of certain expansion projects of the resource development program, "now being undertaken for completion in 1955 or earlier," amounts to \$2,537 millions. Estimates anticipate that, by 1955, "Canadian capacity for production of crude petroleum will have more than tripled and for iron ore will have increased fivefold," as compared with 1950.

The impact of direct rearmament expenditures on the economy, and on the budget, is still to come, the B. of M. emphasizes. "Moreover, the rapidly mounting requirements of defence will enter the economic stream along with the equally important demands of a vigorous and growing program of resource development."

Both activities generated consumer in-civilities. "Together, the prospective broad of defence outlays and industrial expansion not only pre-empt continued high levels of business but also constitute a warning that fundamental inflationary pressures may not yet have run their full course."

Federal Pension Scheme. Between the Old Age Assistance Act, for needy persons of 65-69, and the Old Age Security Act, for all over 70, a total of approximately 845,000 people will benefit from "Canada's new and expensive advance in the field of social security," the bank comments. Not counting the existing plan, the added burden to the Federal Treasury next year will be of the order of \$238-253 millions.

"There are unmistakable signs of compromise" in the methods of financing universal pensions, observes the review. A Joint Committee of the Senate and the House of Commons laid down the principle that the pensions from age 70 should be financed by methods requiring "a direct and conscious payment" by the largest possible number of beneficiaries.

Noting that the cost is to be met by extra personal and corporate income and sales taxes, and that "rather less than half of all those gainfully employed" pay personal income tax, the analysis emphasizes that, "if cannot be said that contributions made to the universal pensions will be, even in part, direct or conscious from the standpoint of the electorate."

"The cost is there, but it is largely 'lost in the shuffle'. The whole matter underlines the difficulty of fitting a new major commitment into a budget of ordinary expenditures already very high." It is "an open question" whether the "rather oblique approach to the financing of universal pensions will wholly dispel the still-prevalent notion that Government benefits come 'for free'."
