Lack of good commercial demand and selling based on hesitation on United States markets were factors in the declines here. Fair shipper orders came out, mostly in oats for domestic interests. Americans picked up rye on recessions. Flax received light processor support. Export loadings of Canadian wheat included 620,000 bushels to the United Kingdom, 370,000 to Malta and 125,000 to Norway. Class two wheat and I. W. A. prices were unchanged. Closing prices: Oats - May 96 1/2; July 86 1/2; Oct. 83 1/2. Barley - May 129 1/2; July 122 1/2; Oct. 118 1/2.
