MARKETS and FINANCE
N. Y. Stocks
NEW YORK (CP) — The stock market had to cope with a whole series of major developments last week—some favorable and some unfavorable.
 It gave a good account of itself by neither falling in panic nor running up in unbridled enthusiasm.
 Among other events was a government blow aimed at stock speculation, a succession of exceptionally high earnings reports by big corporations, some disappointing profit reports and the possibility of peace in the Formosa area.
 In addition to these, a ripple of announcements on dividends and mergers and profits of various companies kept the market in constant movement.
 The Associated Press average of 60 stocks ended the week unchanged at \$164.80.
 Wall street started the week in a nervous frame of mind. Beginning Monday, the new higher margin rules were in effect. The federal reserve board ordered brokers to limit the margin of credit to 30 per cent on the purchase of securities. Previously you could borrow 40 per cent of the price of the stock you bought.
 The margin news had to be balanced against the announcement that steel production this week was estimated to produce the second highest tonnage in the industry's history.
