**CONTRACT BRIDGE**

**QUIZ**

You are South, both sides vulnerable. The bidding has been:  
North East South West  
1 Pass 2 Pass  
3 Pass

What do you bid now with each of the following four hands?  
1. ♠A94 ♥J6 ♦52 ♣KJ8743  
2. ♠743 ♥A94 ♦8 ♣AKQJ72  
3. ♠K7 ♥8 ♠AJ64 ♣KQ9532  
4. ♠KJ3 ♥9752 ♦6 ♣AK954

1. Four hearts. There should be no compunctions about raising with only two trumps in this sequence. The skip to three hearts is nearly always based on a six card or longer suit. The raise to four hearts, since it is in response to North's command to bid again, shows no added values beyond those inferred by the two club bid.

The objection to rebidding the clubs is that partner may bid five clubs, an eleven trick contract which may easily be in greater jeopardy than four hearts.

2. Four notrump. The three heart rebid should create a great interest in arriving at a grand slam contract. If partner has solid hearts and two aces, thirteen tricks are accounted for.

Point count will not solve the problem, but information about suit control will. If partner shows two aces by bidding five hearts, and has at least one king, the grand slam should be ventured.

If partner responds five diamonds, showing one ace and a small slam in hearts will be undertaken.

3. Four diamonds. Prospects for a small slam are good if North can support either clubs or diamonds. If partner bids five clubs, a small slam in clubs should be bid.

If partner bids five diamonds, a small slam in diamonds is bid. North is sure to have four diamonds, since our secondary bid identified only a four card suit.

If North bids four hearts, a pass is in order. Partner's inability to raise either minor suit, and his unwillingness to try for four hearts in his suit, despite our two constructive bids, should persuade us that the best contract has been reached.

4. Five hearts. A bid of four hearts would not properly reflect the excellent support for a heart contract. For an example of a four heart bid see Hand No. 1.

Although there are only 11 points in high cards, the distributional features and suit control make the hand attractive for slam purposes. There do not appear to be two losers if partner voluntarily bids six.

The four notrump request for aces will not solve the problem of the best final contract. The invitation to North to bid a slam, inviting him to use his judgment, is likely to produce the winning contract.
