A CLEVER RUSSIAN.

He thought over the matter, and one morning he sent for a lot of masons. Then he ordered them to build a wall around the dervish, who was sitting in the middle of the room. The dervish watched them placidly at first, but when the wall grew and it became apparent that it would be completed soon he jumped over it, ran away and has not been seen since. They say that the count is the first man in Teheran who has beaten a creditor of this kind without recourse to the police.—New York Press.
