

Combined Area Centennial Day Planned July 3

July 3 is the day for a combined "Centennial Day" celebration for the communities of Parkdale and Sherwood. The day will feature a street dance, skydiving, and a strawberry festival.

A parade, which will wind its way from Sherwood School to the St. Pius X parking lot, will be filled out with the Stadacona Naval Band from Halifax and RCN personnel from the ships Fort Erie and La Hulloise. Parkdale Junior High School is to be the scene of a girls' softball game at 11:15 in the morning, and it will be followed at the exhibition grounds by the first jump of the skydivers.

Official opening ceremonies are scheduled for 1:30 just prior to a track meet. Later Parkdale and Sherwood women's institutes will cater to a strawberry festival during the juvenile baseball game at Parkdale Junior High. The fire departments of both centres are sponsoring the street dance, which will be held in S.R. Johnston's parking lot beginning at 4:30. The Bounty Boys are providing a musical background for the affair.
