Immigration Paper Due

OTTAWA (CP)—The government's white paper on immigration policies will be tabled in the Commons early next month, Immigration Minister Marchand said Tuesday.

He told Andrew Brewin (NDP - Toronto-Greenwood) the document is "almost ready" and will be made public Oct. 5 or shortly afterwards.

The white paper is expected to abolish all remaining restrictions to immigration based on ethnic or geographic origin. Requirements for employment skills would be retained.

Later, Acting Prime Minister Martin told Real Caouette, Creditiste leader, that the government will further encourage immigration from France and expand Canadian facilities there for handling immigrants.
