WINNIPEG, March 11 - (CP) - Fair gains again were scored across the board in all prices today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Commercial demand was good, with shippers taking both oats and barley. Seaboard buying came out in barley in connection with small export business. American houses picked up oats rye and flax. Offerings were light in all grains with no evidence of hedging sales. Export loadings of Canadian wheat included 455,000 bushels to the United Kingdom, 195,000 to Belgium and 300,000 to Japan. Prices for class two wheat and I. W.
