We're Not Hurt Yet, Banks Tells Unionist

By ARCH MACKENZIE OTTAWA (CP) — "Wait till we're shook off the tree, said Hal C. Banks to a supporter, "We're not hurt yet."

The president of the Seafarers' International Union of Canada stood confronting the Parliament Building, cracking jokes, exuding confidence and spreading the word personally to his rank-and-file that he thought they were doing a good job.

"Those guys (members of Parliament) didn't know what the score was—just what they read in the newspapers."

Riding a white Cadillac—he gets a new one every year—Mr. Banks arrived in Ottawa from Montreal SU headquarters to lead Monday's protest by some 2,000 members against federal legislation that will impose a government trusteeship on the SUI and four other maritime unions.

Back and forth he went, imprecise, quick-smiling six-foot figure with a rugged face whose barrel chest and broad shoulders make him seem shorter.

This was the man that Justice T. G. Norris of Vancouver singled out with his union in the federal shipping in-

quiry into the Great Lakes labor war. The judge's report laid the basis for the federal trusteeship.
