Art Critics Defend Collection Of Contemporary Canadian Art

Art critics across the country have come to the defence of a collection of contemporary Canadian art that most of them have never seen.

The collection, scenes of 22 cities from St. John's Nfld. to Victoria, goes on display today in Amsterdam. The reception has been good in most Latin American and European capitals where the paintings have been shown but they were panned in Stockholm and belittled by a critic at home.

Canadian artists and critics, led by Robert Pilot of Montreal, president of the Royal Canadian Academy, recalled that the collection is a fine idea and the paintings are good. Some, however, mentioned their praise and others considered the paintings "commercial" and not representative of Canadian art.
