Heavy rains are causing floods in Vermont. Heavy frosts have done \$1,000,000 damage to crops in San Gabriel Valley, California.

The U. S. war department is ordering all the old ironclads which were used in the civil war to be put in shape for service.

During the week ending Saturday last there were reported in Copenhagen 1,600 cases of influenza and 72 deaths from the disease.

The Connecticut river is the highest in many years, and a trestle of the Rutland railroad has been carried away, causing a suspension of traffic.

One of the prominent questions of British politics is the election of a leader of the Unionist party. The choice of Mr. Chamberlain, if not a foregone conclusion, is at all events highly probable. He is considered the most capable and also the most certain candidate.
