FREDERICK H. MACLEOD
A large circle of relatives and friends were saddened to hear of the death of Frederick H. MacLeod a life long resident of Murray Harbour who passed away on May 11, 1957 at the King's County Hospital. He was of a kind disposition and won the respect and esteem of both young and old. He was happiest in his own home which was the centre of hospitality, where everyone was made welcome and where friends and acquaintances liked to meet. The funeral which was largely attended was held from Murray Harbour United Church on Monday afternoon May 13. Service was conducted by his pastor Rev. L.S. Woolfrey.
