Students Sell Scriptures

University students at a church young people joined in a neighbourhood Scripture distribution campaign in Ceylon. Starting with a study of the Christian Scriptures, the youth felt the urge to give these books to the poor.

Twenty-five packets were sold in one campaign, totaling 400 copies of various portions of the Bible. Each purchaser of a packet is expected to re-distribute to fifteen people in this manner the Scriptures are given very wide distribution.

During the few months it has been operating this Ceylon Bible Scripture Evangelism project has distributed 72 packets containing 12,332 portions.

No Strings to Be Attached To Canada's Aid Program

OTTAWA (CP)—External Affairs Minister Martin said he will be attached to a long-term expanded program of external aid to developing countries.

Mr. Martin appeared as a witness before the committee during discussion of a proposed expenditure during the 1964-65 fiscal year of \$75,000,000 for external aid. This represents an increase of \$5,000,000 compared to a year earlier.

Under this year's aid program grants will be made to Commonwealth developing countries and to other members of the Colombo Plan, to units of the former West Indies Federation and to independent

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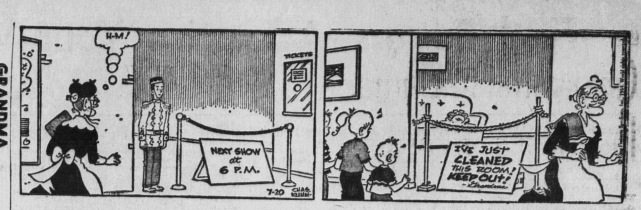
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
