**NEW YORK**  
NEW YORK (AP) — Steels pace a stock market advance in heavy trading Wednesday, reversing an early decline.  
Announcement of price increase for steel by some of the major companies as well as higher prices for steel scrap boosted steel shares from 1 to 5 points or better.  
rest of the list to a general improvement as key stocks in various sections rose from fractions to about 3.  
Plenty of losers remained as a carryover from the market's indifferent performance earlier in the day, so the over-all gain was moderate.  
Building materials, motors, aircrafts, rubbers and various chemicals and oils did well. Ralls aided by favorable Senate action on a bill to aid the carrier, rose to a high for the year.  
The Associated Press average of 60 stocks rose 80 cents to \$122.90 with the industrials up \$1.30 the rails up \$1.20 to their new peak for 1958 and the utilities off 10 cents.  
Among Canadian issues traded, International Nickel led the way with a gain of 1/4. Canadian Pacific added 3/4 and Aluminum Ltd. an Distillers - Seagrams gained 1/4. Hudson Bay Mining lost 1/2.  
In the Canadian list on the American exchange Shawinigan lost 3/4 and Brazilian Tracoin (Continued on page 18)

Miscellaneous stocks saw Dominion Glass up 2 at 80, Ford A up 1 1/2 at 88 1/2 and General Dynamics 1 1/4 higher at 58 1/2. One-point gains were made by Salada B at 40 and General Motors at 41.  
In other groups MacKinnon gained one at 11 and B.A. Oil was up 3/4 at 40 1/2. Asbestos dipped a point to 28 1/2.  
Featured in the enor mines was Falconbridge, up 2 1/2 at 26 1/2. In an irregularly strong penny group, New Hoco more than recovered Tuesday's 40-cent loss with a gain of 50 cents at 2.90.  
The closing averages show banks off 0.03, utilities unchanged at 140.1, industrials up 0.4 at 27.1, combined up 0.3 at 228.8, papers off 2.1 at 376.8 and gold up 0.22 at 70.70.
