filling, or interferes with the action of its walls. The colon (large intestine) can be the most satisfactory part of the stomach and intestine for examination provided good preparation has been accomplished, for one can control the amount and admixture of barium and air and produce the proper double contrast. If necessary and can palpate (feel with the fingers) successfully.

Finally, just as in other parts of the body, emotional and allergic manifestations can produce marked change in the appearance of the bowel. This means that the causes of certain changes in the bowel may be difficult to discover as in most cases these changes do not follow any regular pattern.

From the above fragmentary information about the X-ray of stomach and intestine, we learn that a series of X-rays should be made as a slow-growing cancer can cause confusion when only one X-ray examination is made.
