MONTREAL (CP) — United States dollar in terms of Canadian funds down 1-16 at \$1.07 11-16.  
Pound sterling down 1/4 at \$3.01 13-16.

**NEW YORK**

NEW YORK (AP) — A late push by steels paced the stock market to a moderate gain in active trading Wednesday.  
Gains included U.S. Steel 1/4 at 50 1/2, Bethlehem 1/4 at 38 1/2, Republic 1/4 at 42 and Jones and Laughlin 1/4 at 66 1/4.  
A 4-point spurt by du Pont to 23 1/2 helped push the averages up.  
The Associated Press 80 average advanced 1.0 to 355.4, Dow Jones 4.66 at 958.74 and Standard and Poor up .14 to 92.02.  
429 issues traded, 630 rose, 577 fell. Highs exceeded lows 112 to 41.  
Volume slipped to 9,570,000 from 9,920,000 Tuesday.  
American Photocopy, up 1/4 at 12 1/2 on 283,500 shares, was the most active stock.

Bronswick, off 1/4 at 9 1/2 on 204,500 shares, was second most active. IBM which lost 10 points Tuesday, fell another 1 1/2 to 465 despite denials by it and CBS that they were considering a merger.  
Among Canadians Walker Godefrham was up 1/4, and Aluminum Ltd. and Dome Mines gained 1/4. Canadian Pacific dropped 1/4 and Disasters Seagrams lost 1/4. Hudson Bay Mining dropped 1/4.  
Prices had a slightly higher edge on the American Stock Exchange. Volume inched up to 4,080,000 from 4,030,000 Tuesday.  
Brazilian Tracção and Canadian Javelin added 1/4 and Canadian Marconi dropped 1/4.

MONTREAL (CP) — Stocks turned a shade softer Wednesday, resuming the general downward drift which began earlier in the week on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges.  
Utilities and papers were up but most other sections moved fractionally lower.  
The composite index fell 0.20 to 154.76. Declines led advances 81 to 72.  
Industrial volume was 100,000 and mines and oils 1,182,000 compared with 132,000 and 1,318,000.

Banks were off 0.06 at 119.26. Nova Scotia fell 1/4 to 71 and Montreal 1/4 to 60 1/4. Royal and Toronto Dominion dropped 1/4 to 70 1/4 and 59 1/4.  
Industrials were off 0.36 at 180.49.  
Imperial Tobacco fell 1/4 to 14 1/4.  
Papers rose 0.36 to 113.56. Consolidated and MacMillan B. Loedel and Powell River climbed 1/4 to 38 1/4 and 26.  
Utilities added 0.17 to 151.21. Senior oils were off with Pacific Petroleum dropping 1/4 to 11 1/4. Massey - Ferguson dropped 3/4 points to 32 1/4. Fleetwood fell 1/4 to 26 1/4 and Canadian Marconi 1/4 to 7 1/4.

Among primary metals aluminum dropped 1/4 to 31 1/4. In the base section Hudson Bay slipped one point to 77 and Hollinger 1/4 to 25 1/4.

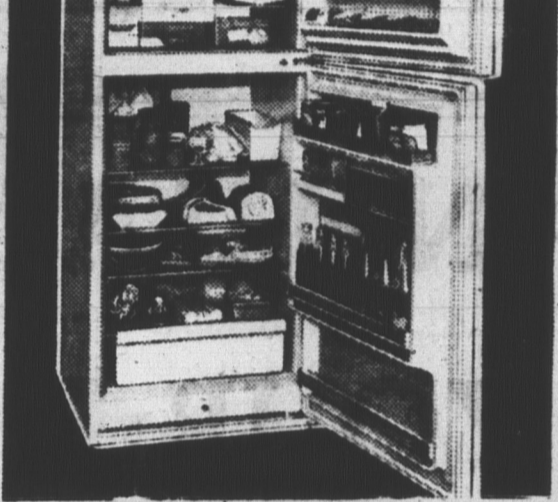
