The Queen has arrived at London, from Balmoral.

The Monetary Times concludes that in Ontario alone new capital has this year been created by labor to the extent of seventy-five million dollars.

Regarding Major Hebert, whose death in Egypt was reported a few days ago, it will be remembered that this young Canadian officer applied for leave to join the army on service, and that permission was obtained by the Governor-General for him to be attached to a battery of the regular artillery.

The Royal University of Ireland has just held its first degree day. It is liberally endowed out of the Irish Church surplus, and its authorities have already bestowed a large number of scholarships, exhibitions, and prizes upon the more distinguished candidates at the first matriculation and degree examinations.

The Conservatives have secured the last three electorates in England. At Preston and Cambridge University the change is not very great, but at Salisbury, Mr. Greenfield, a wealthy young Liberal, was ejected from the seat for which he sought re-election.

Some evenings ago, during a lecture at Laval University by Dr. Verge, one of the professors, the gas was suddenly turned off. Considerable confusion ensued, during which some one got a lamp and attempted to light it, but it was kicked over, and the students finally issued out of the hall in a body, and marched around the ramparts with a torch-bearer at their head, singing "La Marseillaise."
