ENGLISH GRAMMAR AND COMPOSITION.

In the Grammar School, under Messrs. Arbuckle and Goff, are taught the ordinary branches of an English Education, comprising English Grammar, Writing, History, Geography and Arithmetic, with Latin, including the Grammar, Reader, and Cæsar's Gallic War.

By a Bye-Law of the Board of Trustees and Governors of the College, passed on the 20th February last, it was ordered that in future, all Tuition fees for the College and Grammar School departments be paid in advance.
