Speculation Heard Russia May Cut E. German Forces

BERLIN (AP) - Speculation arose in West Germany Thursday that the French pullout from the Atlantic alliance military command may be accompanied by a withdrawal of some Russian troops from Communist East Germany.

The question of Soviet intentions is being discussed against the background of French President de Gaulle's 11-day visit to the Soviet Union starting Monday. The West German newspapers Die Welt and Bild Zeitung carried reports Wednesday quoting informed sources that the Soviets would pull five divisions out of East Germany. Die Welt said the gap would be filled with the greater firepower in the form of more missiles.

Western military observers say Soviet forces in East Germany now total 400,000 men. "Shall We Gather At The River" Organist was Mrs. Annie Kennedy.

Sabotage Reported

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP) - General Electric Co. said Wednesday it had to junk 25,000 refrigerators last month because of sabotage. James M. Olive, an official at GE's appliance park, said a foreign substance, probably sand or sugar, was fed into the paint system of the household refrigerator department.

"All of the cases painted with this had to be scrapped," he said. Olive added that loss of the cases prevented GE from building 25,000 refrigerators it would have placed the market in June. GE declined to put a cost figure on the scrapped cases, outside shells without the insulation motor and refrigerating unit. The discarded units were cut up for scrap and sold.

"We think it's a small group of employees who decided to do this and we can't find out why," Olive said. "The union (Local 761 of the International Union of Electrical Workers) has done all it can to correct the situation."

WOLF WARNED OXFORD, England (CP) - A storeman at an Oxford car plant may lose his job if he sees a pretty girl walking through the factory. John Owen, 21, finds it hard to resist whistling at office girls employed in the plant, but he has been warned he will be sacked if he breaks the rule banning whistling.

Independent-minded Romania also has been reported seeking a lower financial pact. Romanian Communist party leader Nicolai Ceausescu has called for abolition of both the Warsaw Pact and the North Atlantic Treaty Organization.

Western military sources, asked to comment on the reports of a possible withdrawal by the Soviets in East Germany, said they had seen no physical evidence as yet that the Russians were getting ready for such a move.
