AUTUMN ON THE FARM. TIMELY SUGGESTIONS OF VALUE TO AGRICULTURISTS. Keeping Up Pasture Lands—How to Secure the Greater Longevity of Grasses in Fields Given Over to Grazing.

DIVIDING THE PASTURE. An excellent plan for keeping up the fertility of the pasture land is to divide the pastures into two fields, giving the cattle the advantage of the pasture, leaving one field to grow and so remain until spring.

FERTILIZERS. The pasture land receives a heavy drain on its fertility when it supports a herd of cattle, and unless the land is assisted in some manner the supply of grass may fall on the first approach of winter.

Professor Cooke, of the Vermont Experiment Station, states that in his experiments he finds that the ensilage stalks and pulled corn (after the latter is dried) are good for feeding.

Apply 20 bushels of unbleached wood ashes per acre to the clover. If ashes are not easily obtained use the same proportion of air-dried lime. In the spring apply 100 pounds of plaster.

This is the time to seed down for a pasture. Use seed from a variety of grasses, as some kinds will thrive better on certain soils than others.

The value of coal ashes as a fertilizer is not sufficient to authorize their use for that purpose. When the coal ashes contain a good deal of sulphur, which is usually the case, it will pay to use them.

The latest report is that the little red spider has fortunately been exterminated in the Colorado beetle territory, and that during the past season the spiders have multiplied rapidly and destroyed many of the eggs of the beetles.

When one kind of fruit is affected with rot there is a liability of the other kinds rotting also. According to the report of the Agricultural Department, the latter rot of apples is identical with the gray rot, though the latter is not so bitter.
