## BELFAST RAILWAY BILL IN PARLIAMENT.

A telegram to the St. John Sun states that in the House of Commons on Wednesday,

"On the bill for the construction of a railway from Charlottetown to Murray Harbor, Messrs. Foster and Haggart compared the programme of the present government with that of the previous administration. Both exministers accepted the claim of Prince Edward Island for greater consideration. They adhere to the plan laid down by the late government by which 105 miles of railway would have been constructed, bringing the main line into connection with many points on the coast and inland that are now shut out from communication during the great part of the year. They accepted the government proposition as partially meeting the needs of the case, but regretted that so long a time had been lost and that no action was yet taken to meet requirements.

"Some of the Ontario members criticized the proposed expenditure, contending that this was practically a new subsidy.

"This claim was met by Messrs. Macdonald and Martin who showed that their province had been passed over in all the railway subsidy votes of the last twenty years, while millions were expended in the larger provinces for public and private railways and for canals.

### NOTES AND COMMENTS.

—The \$60,000,000 vote fairly took away the breath of the people of Winnipeg. The Tribune of that city—a Liberal paper exclaims that "such enormous expenditures as are called for this year are unparalleled in the history of Canada."

—Concerning the recent judicial appointment in this Province one of the despatches from Ottawa states that "there has been a hot contest among the rival aspirants and the Minister of Marine has had his life made miserable over the matter." We can readily believe this statement of the case. It is not wonderful that Sir Louis has been ill.

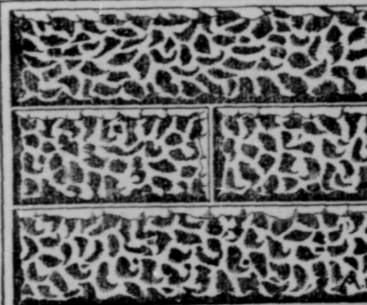
