Another Seaway Contract Is Let

OTTAWA (CP) — A \$7,000,000 contract for construction of the St. Lambert lock and approaches in the Lachine section of the St. Lawrence seaway project, has been awarded to three Toronto construction firms, the seaway authority announced Thursday.

The successful bid, lowest of five tendered, was for \$7,399,472 and was by McNamara Construction Co., Ltd. Pigott Construction Co., Ltd., and Peacock and McQuigge, Ltd., acting jointly. The contract for construction of the lock on the south shore of the St. Lawrence at Victoria bridge in Montreal, was the 28th let so far by the authority and one of the largest. It brought total contracts let so far to \$57,000,000.
