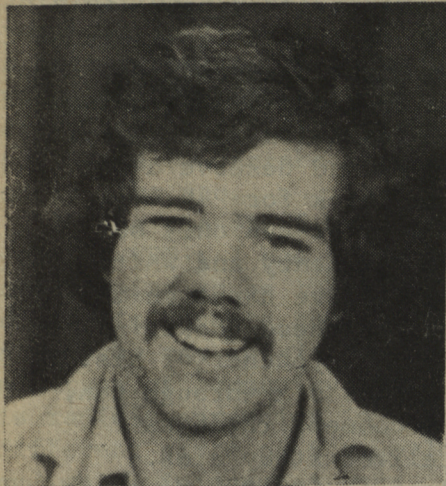


Treasurer

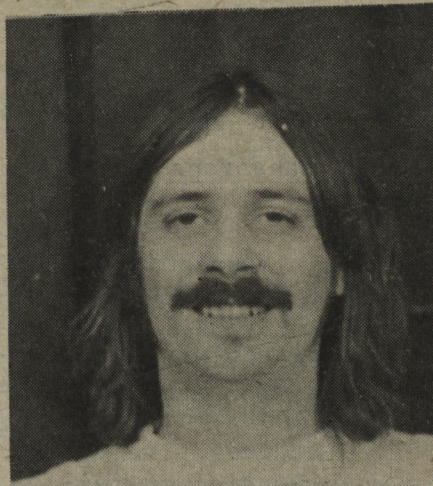
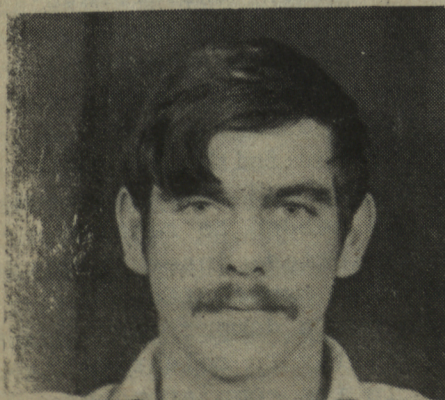

The student representative to the senate provides an effective connection between the individual students and the Hier-

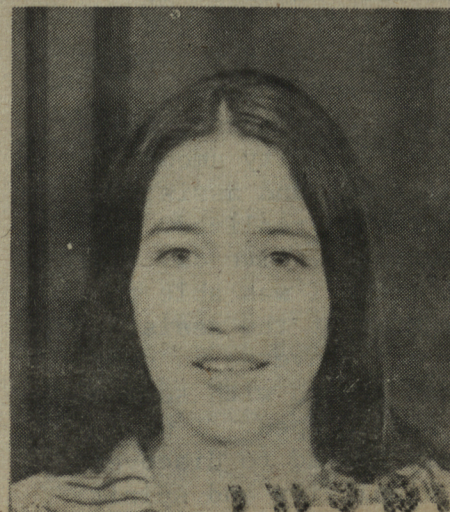

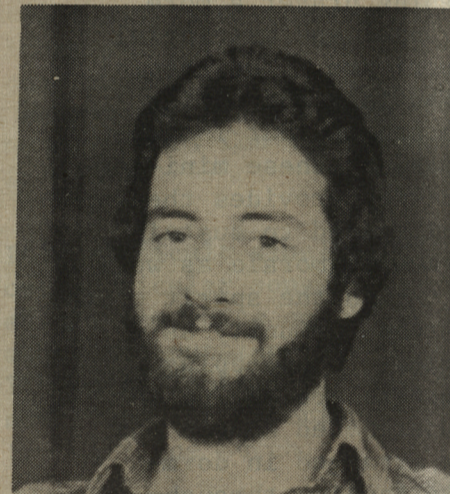
