

Few sections of the Old West were wilder or woollier than Oklahoma Territory of some fifty years ago, around the time of the Land Rush. And this setting and its atmosphere have been recreated in RKO Radio's "Return of the Bad Men," which opens at the Capitol Theatre, Summerside, today with Randolph Scott, Robert Ryan, Anne Jeffreys, George "Gabby" Hayes and Jacqueline White in the stellar roles.

Telling an exciting tale of banditry and law enforcement, the film presents Scott as a former Texas Ranger who is induced to take a U. S. Marshalship to combat the outlaw bands terrorizing the district. Ryan as the Sundance Kid, is discovered as one of the toughest gunmen of that era. Miss Jeffreys portrays a bandit queen who reforms when she falls in love with Scott, and Hayes is seen as a frontier banker.

The interplay of plot between the four principals, and the lawless activities of such noted desperadoes as Bill Doolin, the Youngers, the Daltons, Billy the Kid, and Wild Bill Yeager, all make the picture unusually thrilling. A bandit raid on the town of Braxton, and a second raid which is broken up largely by Scott's efforts, form two of the actionful highlights of the story.

LIBERTYVILLE, Ill. (AP)—Adlai Stevenson said Wednesday the Democratic victory at the polls Tuesday "was a portent of things to come." He obviously referred to the 1952 election.

"This election has been a marked change from the last two years and, historically, mid-term elections have been a portent of what is to come," Stevenson told a press conference at his nearby home at Half Day, Ill.

But the election, he added quickly with a twinkle, "has nothing

whatever to do with whether I'll run again for the presidency." That was the only reference by Stevenson, the 1952 Democratic nominee for the presidency, as to whether he would seek the office again.
