Slash Research Appropriation

WASHINGTON (AP) — A two-month-old directive which the defence department made public early Sunday slashes military research and development spending by at least \$170,000,000.

The order was signed by defence secretary Charles Wilson before his recent retirement, was not made public at the time.

The Washington Post and Times Herald said some holders of U.S. Air Force contracts for basic research have complained that the amount done to research will be cut of proportion to the money saved.

GENEVA (AP) — Italian movie director Roberto Rossellini said that all talk of a divorce from his wife, Ingrid Bergman is "absolute nonsense."

"Rossellini arrived from Bombay and changed planes in Geneva to join Ingrid in Paris for two days. A reporter asked: "What about your lady friend?" — referring to the Italian movie star Sonali Das Gupta, with whom Rossellini has been romantically linked in current rumors.

"Rossellini smiled and replied: "I have no lady friend." He said "My wife and I have never parted and have no intention of parting."

Hughland Nelson, Montreal. Dr. Gordon Bates, general director of the league, said the league "is the Canadian citizen's committee of the World Health Organization and has an active interest in health problems in all parts of the world."
