CONTRACT BRIDGE

QUIZ

Your right hand opponent deals and bids One Spade, both sides vulnerable. What do you bid now with each of the following four hands?

- 1. ♠QJ93 ♥K82 ♦AQ6 ♣AJ6 2. ♠AQ ♥KJ5 ♦972 ♣AKQ63 3. ♠J764 ♥A5 ♣AK ♦J8532 4. ♠- ♥AK84 ♦KQ98 ♣AKJ2

1. One notrump. This bid mirrors the high card content of the hand, the distribution and the scattered strength, all in one motion. The requisites of the one notrump overall are very similar to the one notrump opening bid. The point count is the same, 16 to 18; the distribution generally the same, 4-3-3-3 or 4-4-3-2; the honor cards fairly evenly divided in the four suits. Usually, the overcaller has two stoppers in the suit he is overcalling. The strength exists, of course, to make an informative double, but this would infer a primary interest in finding a suit contract, which is not the case. Furthermore, there will be no clear answer to what to do next when partner responds to the double with two of any suit. 2. Double. The hand is too good for a two club overall. The extra values above an overall are best represented by the informative double. There is no assurance that clubs is the best trump for the partnership, and

the opportunity to play hearts or diamonds whenever partner has five or six of either should be given. 3. Pass. Although this hand constitutes an opening bid which should be made as dealer, the adverse spade bid takes a lot of wind out of our sails. An informative double would be reckless, in view of the absence of proper support for either hearts or diamonds, and might run us into a tidy penalty double. The same catastrophe might ensue from a two club overall, where the announced trump-suit has neither strength nor length sufficient to recommend it. In view of the spade bid, our hand is now better suited for defense than offense. Let's hope the opponents get into trouble instead of our stepping out to look for it. 4. Two spades. The immediate overall in the opponent's suit alerts partner to an enormous hand which we propose to play in a game contract, probably in the suit he chooses. It is a super-informative double. The bid is rare because the hand to warrant a cue bid is rare. We have every reason to insist upon playing in a game contract because of the high card values and the adaptability of the hand to any suit partner names. An informative double does not tell the story nearly as well.

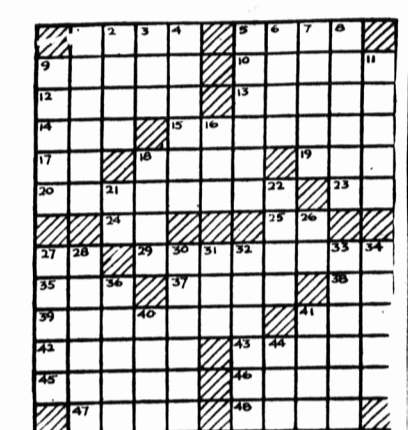

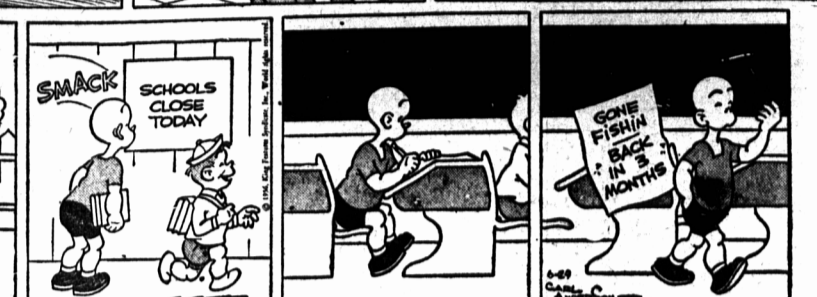
