

### Forgives Hubby For Spending On Girl Friend

LONDON (AP)—A grey-haired wife testified Tuesday she has forgiven her 81-year-old baronet husband for spending more than \$100,000 on a mistress.

Lady Ralli testified she had always loved Sir Strati Ralli "and always will." They have been married 44 years.

Learning of his association with former model Jacqueline Gray came as "an awful shock," Lady Ralli declared, but she told him: "I will stand by you always and will never leave you." That, she said, "comforted him."

Miss Gray, 41, is suing Sir Strati for return of jewels worth \$33,600 which she claims the baronet gave her and then took away on the pretense that he wanted to get them insured.

Sir Strati earlier confessed to his wife that he had been keeping a mistress for 16 years and said all payment to her then stopped.

Under cross examination, Lady Ralli said she first knew of Miss Gray's existence Aug. 30, 1955. Miss Gray and Sir Strati met during the war.

### Dulles Says U. S. - Canadian Problems Being Dealt With

WASHINGTON (CP) — State Secretary Dulles said Tuesday a wide range of problems has arisen between Canada and the United States but suggested they are being dealt with in a manner which, to him, is "on the whole highly satisfactory."

"There is no absolutely satisfactory solution to all of these problems," he told his weekly press conference, "but we have had good relations indeed with the present government of Canada."

Relationships between the two countries, he added, are being maintained "very satisfactorily." Current frictions between Canada and the U.S. came in for brief review when a reporter asked Dulles for his comment on why relationships are strained and what could be done to improve them.

There is no doubt "some difficulties" exist between the two countries, Dulles replied. There had been "differences of opinion" about U.S. agricultural disposal policies which "the Canadians tend to feel... tend to deny them advantageous markets where otherwise they perhaps would be able to sell on a dollar or cash basis."

Another issue had been raised by the U.S. government's decision to restrict imports of foreign oil into the U.S. West Coast market. There also were "quite a few" trade problems.

Dulles recalled the desire expressed by the Progressive Conservative government to buy more from the United Kingdom and to divert some of Canada's trade from the United States.

Canadians "so had shown concern" over the fact that American investments in Canada are so substantial that they might bring about economic policies which might not be to the best interests of Canada.

### Need Funds To Harness A-Power

WASHINGTON (AP) — The chief of U.S. efforts to harness H-bomb power for industrial uses said Monday the project will be "in serious trouble" unless more funds are provided.

Dr. Arthur E. Ruark, chief of the controlled thermonuclear research branch of the Atomic Energy Commission made the statement before the subcommittee on research and development of the Senate-House of Representatives atomic energy committee.

Senator Clinton Anderson (Dem. N. M.) had asked Ruark whether present funds are adequate for the thermonuclear research program.

Later, when asked by reporters to amplify, Ruark said the program "would be hard-pinched" on the present regular budget which he said calls for \$22,500,000 during the year starting next July 1.

Ruark said the AEC is considering asking for a supplementary appropriation.

He estimated that unless a supplementary appropriation comes, the construction of a new type research machine at Princeton University, called the "Stellarator-C," will be slowed to two-thirds, or even one-half, the pace project officials now are shooting for.

- Scald 1/2 cup milk. Stir in 1/2 cup shortening, 1/2 cup granulated sugar, 1 1/2 teaspoons salt, 1 1/2 cups bran flakes. Cool to lukewarm.
- Meantime, measure into bowl 1/2 cup lukewarm water. Stir in 2 teaspoons granulated sugar. Sprinkle with contents of 2 envelopes Fleischmann's Active Dry Yeast. Let stand 10 minutes, THEN stir well. Stir in bran mixture and 1 well-beaten egg, 1 1/2 cups once-sifted all-purpose flour and beat until smooth and elastic.

Work in an additional 1 1/2 cups (about) once-sifted all-purpose flour.

- Turn out on lightly-floured board and knead until smooth and elastic. Place in greased bowl. Brush top with melted butter or margarine. Cover. Let rise in a warm place, free from draft, until doubled in bulk, about 1 1/2 hours.
- Punch down dough. Halve the dough; form each half into an 8-inch roll. Cut each roll into 8 equal pieces. Cut each piece into 3 and form into small, smooth balls. Place 3 balls in each section of greased muffin pans. Brush balls with melted butter or margarine. Cover. Let rise until doubled in bulk, about 1 hour. Bake in a hot oven, 400°, about 15 minutes. Yield—16 gems.
