To Charles Dalton of Tignish and Robert T. Oulton of Alberton belong the credit of first breeding the silver black fox in captivity. A litter from a pair of silver black foxes caught in Lot 40, P. E. I. laid the foundation of silver fox breeding in Prince Edward Island.
