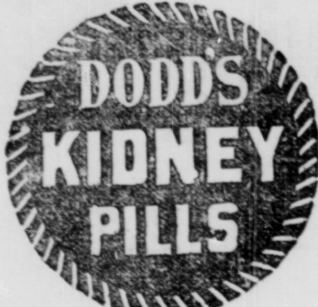

FROM OCEAN DEPTHS.

A New Kind of Fish Found by the Scientists of the Albatross. One of the most important and interesting cruises ever made by the United States ship Albatross has just been completed.

The vessel in her cruise was in charge of Z. B. Miller of the United States Fish Commission. He told of the trip of the Albatross in a very interesting way, explaining the mysterious deep-sea fishing.

"The queerest fish that I ever saw the like of which has never been seen before, was twenty-six inches long and weighed between eight and nine pounds. It was taken at a point about 20 miles southwest of the Fribourg Islands, at a depth of 1,700 fathoms.

"When the Albatross reached the Fribourg Islands, I stopped and spent some time there in the afternoon. I took many photographs of them. The Government requires every year. The islands are photographed in sections, and the sections are afterward put together, so that an entire view is reproduced. In this way the photographs can be compared with those of previous years.

SARONY AND HIS NYMPHS.

New York's Great Artist is Devoted to Nude Idealism. Napoleon Sarony, one of America's oldest and best known artists, has recently taken up a career in original and extremely interesting work of art.

Sarony's work is photographic nude women in every pose possible. At his disposal he has several hundred famous models, and in his private studio he photographs them in the attitudes in which the French painters have painted famous nudes.

Mr. Sarony has had a studio purposefully fitted up for making his nude studies. He began by making just single figures, and then arranged groups of twos and threes, and finally arranged so that he could take eight or ten figures grouped together.

His method of studying the nude and getting the wonderful effect from it which he alone has been able to produce is extremely interesting. First, with the greatest care the model is placed in position—each limb has to be separately placed by the artist.

The likeness is destroyed, partly because the model requests it, but more often because it is not all the artist wishes it to be. So in the second stage every all-important detail is taken care of, and the model is made to be a headless object of beauty until he has time to complete them by painting in good features.

The majority of Mr. Sarony's models are chorus girls, "living pictures" and concert hall singers.
