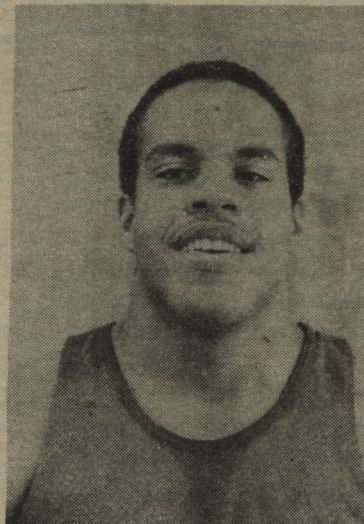
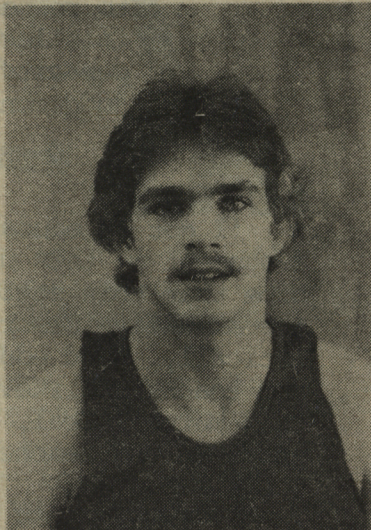


# UPEI BOUNCING BROTHERS

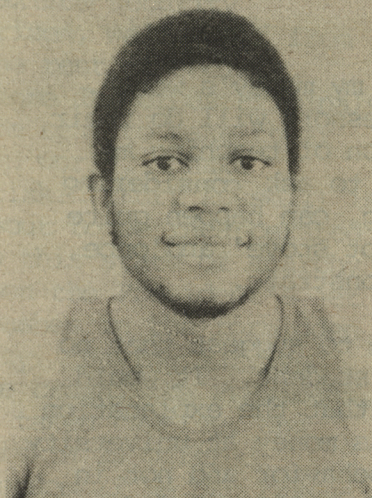

The men's basketball team is unique to be proud of. The fine athletic talent and coaching techniques.

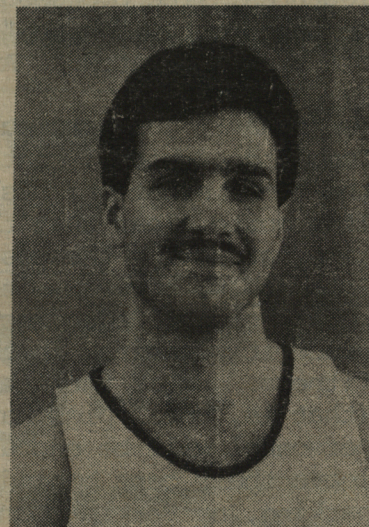

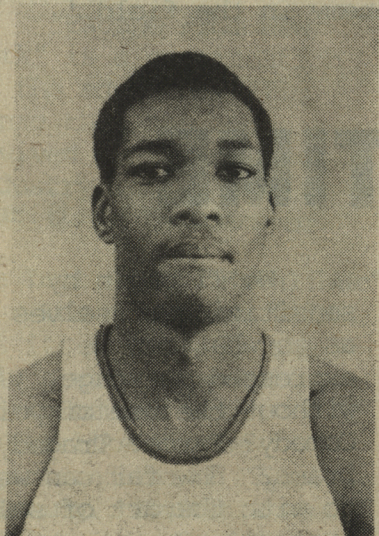

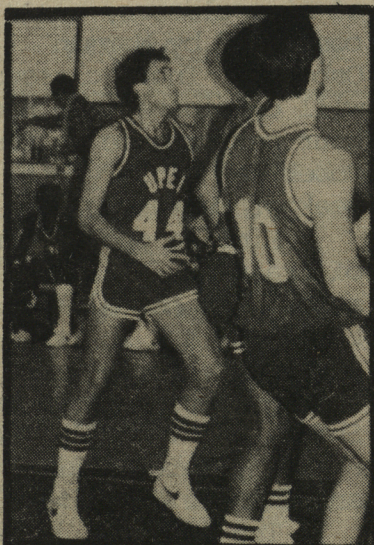
