**SALMON AND CHEESE RING LOAF**  
3 Sun-kist lemons (quarter) 1 egg, beaten  
2 cups (1 lb.) Canned Salmon 2 tbsps. melted butter  
1 cup grated Canadian cheese 1 tspn. salt  
1 cup cracker crumbs 1/2 tspn. celery salt  
2/3 cup milk 1/2 tspn. pepper

Drain and flake Salmon, reserving 1/3 cup for decoration. Combine Salmon with other ingredients. Shape by hand into oval ring, on shallow baking dish. Top with reserved Salmon flakes, dot with butter, bake in moderate oven (350 deg. F.) about 30 minutes or until golden brown. Put center with hot butter — but not potatoes and garnish with Sun-kist lemon quarters. Serve with medium-thick white sauce. Serves 6.
