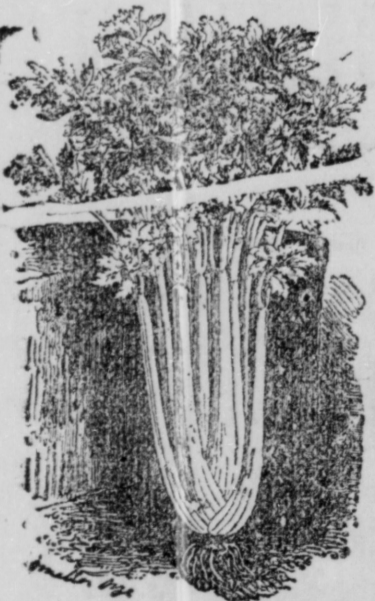

STORY OF STEVENSON.

A story is being told of the endeavour, which failed, made by the late Robert Louis Stevenson to master the Gaelic language. Mr. Charles J. Guthrie, Q. C., who has just been appointed Sheriff of Ross and Cromarty, replying to the welcome given him by the Bar at Stornoway, bemoaned one drawback in the education given him in his youth—he had not been instructed as he should have been in the earliest language of the world, and he feared he was too old to acquire the Gaelic now. Robert Louis Stevenson, he said, told him he had spent a considerable amount of time and trouble trying to learn the language, and at last thought he had advanced so far that he might speak it. He addressed an old Highland woman in a simple sentence which he supposed and intended to be Gaelic, but what was his chagrin when the old body calmly informed him that she "did not have the English!"

A despatch to the 'Daily Mail' from Lisbon says that President Kruger was accompanied on board the Dutch warship 'Gelderland,' at Lorenzo Marquez, by three exalted Portuguese officials. Before sailing he assured the governor on his honor that he would go direct to Holland, calling at Marseilles.

The search for buried arms has resulted in the unearthing at Hector Spruit of two pom-poms and two Creusot guns. The remainder of the fifteen-pounders and Krupp field guns have all been found alongside the Crocodile River.

The new British Minister to China, Sir Ernst Mason Satow, has arrived in Peking and Sir Claude H. Macdonald the retiring minister, who has been appointed British minister to Japan, has gone there.

Two additional British generals, Chermiside and Hutton, are returning home from South Africa.

THE KISS PATROL.

One of the Latest Stories Told About Admiral Dewey.

"While I was up in New York during the Dewey celebration," said a federal official, "I had an interesting talk with an old friend of mine who is in the secret service and who was there on special detail to look after some of the distinguished guests. Just how many government detectives were on hand nobody knows except Chief Wilkie, and he isn't apt to tell, but there were enough to put a very prompt quietus on any crank or indiscreet enthusiast

who might have been inclined to make things unpleasant.

"It seems that Dewey had a particular dread of being kissed. He probably remembered how poor Hobson had been osculated into obscurity, and the first thing he asked of the members of the arrangement committee who boarded the Olympia in the bay was that all females who looked as if they had intentions should be kept at a distance.

"The committee pledged him the honor of New York that he would be protected, but they realized at once that they had the biggest kind of a contract on their hands. It is no easy job to guard a hero against chaste salutes. It would never do to tell every lady who came to be presented that she mustn't kiss the admiral, for nine-tenths of them would certainly regard such a caution as a downright insult. Then, too, the thing is so quickly done! It might be all over before Dewey could yell for help. The only plan was sleepless vigilance, and it was exercised to the limit.

"When a woman was spotted who looked as if she might be meditating a rush and a smack, she would suddenly find herself carried backward into the throng. It seemed like the natural swaying of the crowd, and how it really happened could only have been explained by the dozen or more quiet gentlemen in citizens' clothes who always bobbed up mysteriously whenever the admiral halted in his triumphal progress. They had several bad scares; but, taken altogether, the kiss patrol was a huge success. It was the first time on record that the government ever ordered a blockade on human lips."—New Orleans Times-Democrat.
