CONTRACT BRIDGE

Solomon then trumped a diamond and business started to look great when everybody followed. Trumps were next drawn, dummy contributing two spades. The deuce of clubs toward dummy's jack brought down the curtain. West took his ace but had to return a club. Off went Charles's three spade losers on the Jack of clubs and dummy's good diamonds.

You'll find that if South discards his spades on the A-K of diamonds the hand can't be made. West just has to be careful to prevent declarer from getting to dummy to cash his good diamonds. The two high clubs must be chucked on the A-K of diamonds if the hand is to be made.

I doubt Charles's Biblical name-sake could have done any better.

Opening lead—nine of spades.

Every one in a while I see a hand or hear about a hand that makes me want to stand up and cheer. Here's one such hand, played by Charles Solomon, of Philadelphia, in the first session of the Summer National Championships when they were held in Chicago two years ago.

Maybe the bidding won't meet with unanimous approval, but there was Charlie sitting South in a slam he kind of got trapped into. And to make matters worse, West opened his singleton spade.

You can study this hand for a long time before you'll ever figure out how he made the slam. And if you work it out you can pat yourself on the back for a job well done.

It didn't take Solomon long to decide he was in a bad contract. He was playing duplicate and he knew he was in for a bad score if he didn't produce the slam. If he went down an extra trick or two trying to make it, it couldn't make much difference.

So he went ahead and played all out for the only chance there was to win twelve tricks. After taking the ace of spades he cashed the A-K of diamonds and discarded K-Q of clubs!

One Federal Constituency Has New Name This Election

OTTAWA (CP) — One federal constituency will bear a new name in the June 10 election.

The riding of Northumberland, N.B., has become Northumberland-Miramichi, mainly to distinguish it from Northumberland, Ont., another federal constituency.

The change was approved at the 1955 session of Parliament at the request of G. McWilliam, Liberal MP for the New Brunswick constituency and chairman of the commons privileges and elections committee.

There was no debate on Mr. McWilliam's bill to change the name of his riding, which had been known as Northumberland since Confederation.

Mr. McWilliam said he wished to add the "great and historic name of Miramichi" to that of

Northumberland to "avoid confusion." The Miramichi river in New Brunswick is one of the most famous salmon streams in the Atlantic region.

The Northumberland, Ont., riding was established under the redistribution act of 1914 which merged the former ridings of Northumberland east and Northumberland west. It is represented in the Commons by Dr. Fred G. Robertson, parliamentary assistant to Health Minister Martin.

There was no redistribution of federal constituencies during the last parliament elected Aug. 10, 1953. The last major distribution was made in 1953 before the vote that year.

At the 1957 session of parliament, Fernand Girard, independent member for the Quebec constituency of Lapointe, named after the late Justice Minister Ernest Lapointe, introduced a bill to change the name of his riding.

He proposed the name of Jonquiere - Kenogami - Arvida — the three Saguenay river towns in the constituency—but the bill never came up for approval.

Federal constituencies still bearing duplicate names are Kent, N.B. and Kent, Ont., and Victoria, Ont., and Victoria, B.C.
