WINNIPEG, Sept. 28 (CP)—Prices generally were lower in dull trade today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Lack of support contributed to the weakness rather than consistent offerings. Commercial demand in oats and barley was thin and limited to a few shipping orders. Offerings were light in October oats which showed some resistance to the downward trend. Rye declined under local selling while shippers purchasing on the decline. Crushers were light buyers in flux. The United Kingdom was allocated 500,000 bushels of Canadian wheat; Belgium 375,000 bushels; South Africa 300,000; and Bolivia a small cargo. Lakehead reports showed 96,000 bushels of Canadian wheat had cleared for Oslo, Norway. Class two wheat and I.W.A. prices remained unchanged from yesterday.
