Free Writing Workshops Continue

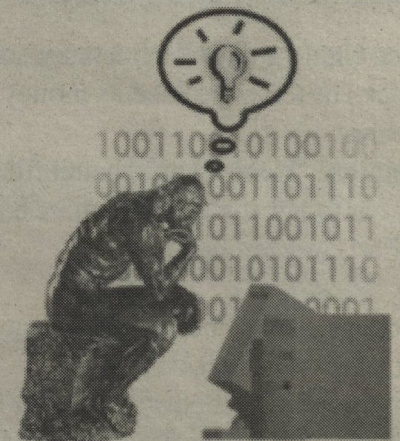
