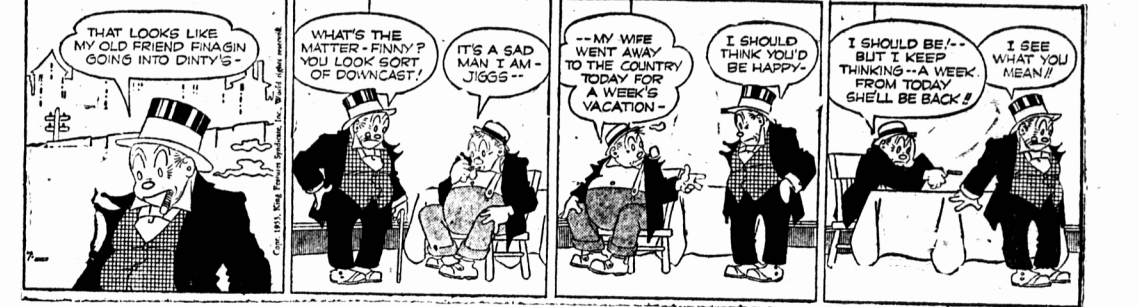

tender."

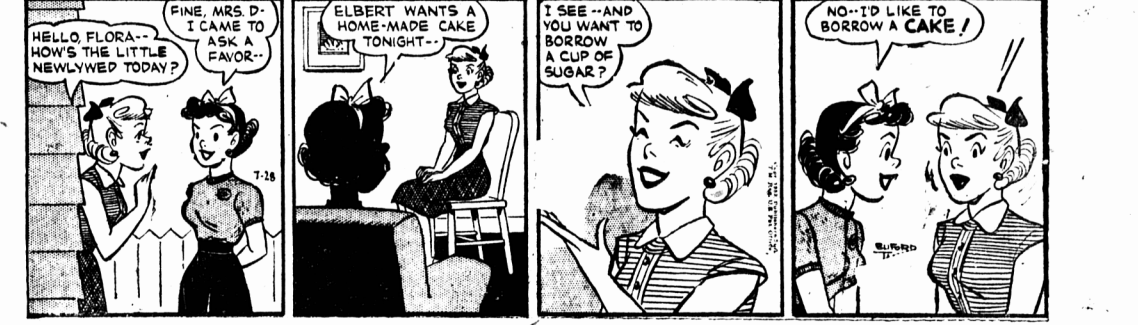
