

**Price Boost  
Danger Seen**

MONTREAL (CP)—G. Arnold Hart, president of the Bank of Montreal, warned Tuesday that with the economy booming and labor shortages occurring in some key points there is "a very real danger" of further price increases.

He called for a "little judicious and moderate restraint" in fiscal and monetary policy.

Speaking to the railway treasury officers' annual meeting here, Mr. Hart said prices started to turn up significantly about a year ago.

"Not that there is runaway inflation or anything approaching it... but it is especially important for Canada that prices stay in line, since so much of our business is based on export trade."

The recent sale of Canadian wheat to Russia "puts added strain on an economy already practically going 'full-out.'"

Government and business, he continued, must be careful that the current period of economic expansion does not end in a recurrence of the "all-too-familiar phenomenon of boom and bust."

Judicious and moderate restraint will pay dividends in the form of further orderly and solid economic progress by stretching out the present period of growth, he said.
