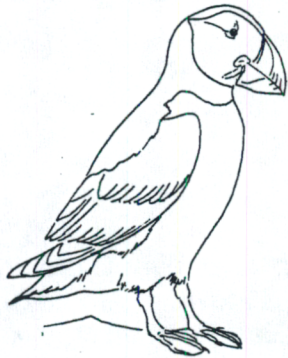


Nov. 9 - 13 (EVL), 4 at East Point on Nov. 9 (JDM, RC), 1 at Argyle Shore on Nov. 17 (JDM); **Lesser Black-backed Gull** - at least 10 seen daily in North Lake vicinity between Nov. 17 & 20, 2 at Elmira on Nov. 18, 3 singles in fields around Rollo Bay, & 1 at North Lake - mostly adults with a couple of 3<sup>rd</sup> years (EVL), 1 at East Point on Nov. 9 (JDM, RC), 1 on Nov. 23 at Borden (EMa); **Glaucous Gull** - 2 at East Point on Nov. 9 (JDM, RC); **Great Black-backed Gull** - 1 between East Point & North Lake on Nov. 5 (DK); **Black-legged Kittiwake** - 60 at East Point on Nov. 2 (RC), 20 at East Point on Nov. 9 (JDM, RC), seen every day from Nov. 17 to 20 with hundreds on several days, mostly adults, on Nov. 18 North Lake to East Point (EVL); **Gull spp.**- 1,000s at Borden on Nov. 23 (EMa); **Caspian Tern** - 1 being harassed by a Parasitic Jaeger at Stanhope Beach on Oct. 4 (MWh), 4 at Covehead on Oct. 8 (DSe), 2 at East Point on Oct. 21 (DSe), and 2 at Rollo Bay on Oct. 21 (DSe); **Common Tern** - 20 at Covehead in Sept, 3 in early Oct., 1 on Oct. 7 (DSe), 2 at Sherbrooke on Oct. 24 (JDM); **UID Alcids** - in good numbers but too far off shore to identify on Nov. 18 (EVL); **Razorbill** - 2 at East Point on Nov. 2 (RC), 1 between East Point & North Lake on Nov. 5 (DK), almost daily at East Point from Nov. 17<sup>th</sup> to 20 with about 80 individuals on Nov. 18 (EVL); **Black Guillemot** - 1 at East Point on Oct. 15 (DSe), 1 between East Point & North Lake on Nov. 5 (DK), 1 at

(LY, JDM, WFB); **Great Horned Owl** - 3 in woodlands at Hardy's Pond on Oct. 1 (MJ&RM); **Snowy Owl** - 1 on fencepost at Traveller's Rest on Nov. 17 (EL, BSo); on Nov. 20 at 5 am at Victoria Park (KG), 1 at Borden on Nov. 23 (EMa, DK); **Short-eared Owl** - 1 at River Platte in upper salt marsh in Sherbrooke (LY, JDM); **UID Owls** - calling at Fairview in late Aug. & early Sept. (I&DB); **Belted Kingfisher** - 1 at Basin Head on Nov. 4 (DSe, EMa); **Red-bellied Woodpecker** - 1 at Macphail Homestead on Nov. 20 (GS), Nov. 21 (DK), Nov. 22 (EMa); **Yellow-bellied Sapsucker** - Rte 114 in Kings on Sept. 16 (DSe); **Downy Woodpecker** - male gleaning seeds of an evening primrose stalk at Rocky Point on Nov. 5 (LD); **Yellow-shafted Flicker** - 1 at Cavendish on Oct. 22 (DSe), 1 at East Point on Nov. 4 (DSe); **Yellow-throated Vireo** - 1 at St. Patrick's Road on Sept. 9 (AG); **American Crow** - 1,000 flying west at Hampton on Nov. 21 (JDM, LY); **Common Raven** - 5 at Sherbrooke on Oct.

20 & 4 at Hampton playing in wind currents off coastal cliff on Nov. 21 (JDM), **Horned Lark** - 20 between East Point & North Lake on Nov. 5 (DK), at Sheep Pond in Souris on Nov. 6 (DSe, EMa); **Grey-headed (Boreal) Chickadee** - at Reed's & Rushes Trail in Dalvay on Oct. 8 (DSe), 5 at Auburn Demonstration Woodlot on Oct. 28 (JDM, RPh); **Black-capped Chickadee** - 3 at Auburn Demonstration Woodlot on Oct. 28 (JDM, RPh); **Red-breasted Nuthatch** - several calling in larch woods in Donagh on Sept. 22 (JDM), 7 at Auburn Demonstration Woodlot on Oct. 28 (JDM, RPh); 10 at Bubbling Springs Trail in Dalvay on Nov. 2 (SCI), present between East Point & North Lake on Nov. 6 (DSe, EMa); **White-breasted Nuthatch** - 1 at Valleyfield woodlot on Oct. 31 (JDM, SW), 1 at New Dominion feeder on Nov. 21 & 22 (EMa); **Brown Creeper** - 1 on Sept. 9 & 1 on Oct. 16 at Bubbling Springs Trail (DSe); **Townsend's Solitaire** - 1 off Route 16 near East Point on Nov. 11 (EVL&MacD); **American Robin** - dozens at Hampton on Oct. 19 in flocks of 3 to 15 feeding on Mountain Ash berries (JDM), 100s eating mountain ash in hedgerows at Argyle Shore on Nov. 3 (JDM, LY), dozens at Rice Point on Nov. 3 (EMa), 7 at Argyle Shore hedgerows on Nov. 17 (JDM); **Northern Mockingbird** - 1 on west side of St. Peter's Bay on Oct. 10 (EVL), 1 on Nov. 4 at Egmont Bay (GMa); **American Pipit** - 1 between East Point & North Lake on Nov. 5 (DK); **Bohemian Waxwing** - large flocks in eastern PEI on Nov. 9 - 11 (EVL), 100 between East Point & North Lake on Nov. 5 (DK), 50 near North Lake on Nov. 6 (DSe, EMa), coming into shore at East Point from direction of Cape Breton on Nov. 17 (EVL); **Cedar Waxwing** - 20 at Mount Stewart on Nov. 9 (JDM, RC); **Northern Parula** - in Murray Harbour area on
