**FRENCH LINE MAY OPERATE HERE**

HALIFAX, Nov. 28—A cable from Paris states that the Compagnie Generale Transatlantique, availing itself of the new Franco-Canadian Commercial Treaty, will run special mail steamers to Canada, receiving the subsidy of 3,000,000 francs, paid equally by Canada and France. This company which is popularly known as the French Line, operates some of the finest liners in the New York service including La Provence, La Touraine, La Lorraine and La Bretagne. The steamer La Bourgoigne which was lost in collision off Sable Island and La Champagne which was towed into Halifax with a broken tail shaft several years ago, belonged to this line. The French Line now runs from Havre to New York and under the proposed arrangement will doubtless transfer some of their New York boats to the Halifax service.

**DREAM TOLD WHERE DEAD BODY LAY**

PORTLAND, Me., Nov. 28—The body of Alfred E. Strout, engineer of the United States Government steamer Nerka, employed at this port, who is believed to have committed suicide about two weeks ago by drowning, because of feeble health, was found yesterday afternoon wedged in between the rocks on the shore near Mount Pleasant Cemetery, at South Portland, by Sexton William White, who has charge of the cemetery. Mr. White dreamed a few nights ago that the body was there, but paid no further attention to the dream, until yesterday he was forced to go to the place as his dream still haunted him. On reaching the place indicated by the dream, Mr. White found the body which was clothed, but the face and hands were badly decomposed, and showed evidence of having been eaten by the fishes.

In answer to the request of the New York Herald for an opinion regarding the effect on the earth of the passing Halley's comet, says that the direct effect will be an increased interest in astronomy. The physical results being facts of interest are therefore patient. The comet is as yet only a telescopic object and is now on its way from Jupiter toward Mars and much nearer it was thought to foretell the Norman or the latter. It was observed here in Orion on October 23 by Mrs. La and others, and showed a round nebulous mass with slight red tinge condensation toward the centre, no tail was visible. From calculation on the latest observations it should pass perihelion about April 20 and, judging by earlier records, should be a fairly bright object in April and May 1910. It will not be as superb as in 1066, when it was thought to foretell the Norman conquest.
