PARTIES using the Telephone would find talking much more satisfactory if they would observe the following rules:— 1. Speak with the mouth about four inches from the transmitter.

2. Speak in a moderate tone of voice, not too loud, and distinctly. 3. Place the telephone so as to cover the ear, do not press too hard on the ear.

4. It is possible to talk and be heard when standing back two or three feet from the transmitter, if you speak loud enough, but it is not a pleasant mode of conversation, is entirely unnecessary, and is a useless waste of wind and lungs, besides being very annoying to all within range of your voice.
