### CANADIAN ACTORS WELL RECEIVED FOR EFFORTS IN PLAY "SAINT JOAN"

OTTAWA, (CP)—The Canadian Players made a bold entry onto the stage of Canadian theatre Tuesday night.

Using an actress, six actors and the stage manager in the 19 roles of George Bernard Shaw's "Saint Joan," they surprised an audience that included Governor-General Vincent Massey, diplomats and delegates here for the Colombo plan conference.

Ann Casson, in the title role, was on familiar ground. She played the part, originally interpreted by her mother, Dame Sybil Thorndyke, during a two-year run in Britain and Europe.

Her performance was well received by the audience, but other members of the cast seemed especially to deserve the applause for nothing but remembering which characters they were and when. No costumes were used, and stage settings were limited to a table and three small benches.

**PLAYS FOUR PARTS**

Roland Hewgill, who gained his first experience with the International Players in Kingston, Ont.,

held the record for parts. He played four, ranging from a plous Brother Martin to a wily, if maidly, Bluebeard in the court of the Dauphin.

Four others, including director Douglas Campbell, portrayed three characters each.

The Canadian Players are an outgrowth of the Stratford Shakespearean festival. Its organizers are Tom Patterson of Stratford, who organized the festival there, and Mr. Campbell, an English actor who has performed at Stratford and is Miss Casson's husband.

Mr. Campbell said the simplicity of the set grew from the simplicity of staging at the Stratford festival. The program described the production as "the platform version of 'Saint Joan,'" and "the bare bones of play acting." The simplicity idea had been carried further on the theory that the play would be equally exciting with six or seven persons each playing two or more roles.

The group will tour 22 Canadian centres.

### Major Magnetic Storm Reported

LONDON, (Reuters)—A major magnetic storm coupled with sunspot activity is seriously affecting short-wave radio communications over a large area of the earth.

Conditions are likely to remain bad until Saturday. From then until Oct. 15 radio experts here expect a brief improvement followed by another deterioration expected to last until about Oct. 20.

Radio experts said Tuesday circuits most severely affected at present are those over the north Atlantic and in the Europe to Asia direction.

But Reuters dispatches from South Africa have reported severe disturbances on that route from Europe.

Intermittent communications trouble is expected to last for about six months and then the current cycle of sunspots is calculated to tail off.

### VAN DOOS CELEBRATE

MONTREAL (CP)—Prime Minister St. Laurent and Governor-General Massey have been invited to attend the 40th anniversary celebrations of the Royal 22nd (Van Doos) Regiment here Oct. 24. Ceremonies here and in Quebec City will open with a mass sung by senior army chaplains and will take the form of a memorial service for those that died in service.

### Damaged Liner Has New Problem

HOBOKEN, N. J., (AP)—The damaged liner Maasdam, back in Hoboken with 25 sit-down passengers still aboard, was beset with another problem Tuesday—the longshoremen's strike.

The ship returned to the Holland-America line pier here Monday to unload its cargo before going into drydock at Brooklyn, N.Y., but the waterfront strike may delay the departure for Brooklyn, scheduled for today.

Meanwhile, her 25 stubborn passengers, mostly young German students returning home, were booked for passage on the Queen Mary and Gripsholm sailing today, and on the Independence sailing Friday.

The 15,000-ton Maasdam collided with a French freighter with a few hours after it put out from Hoboken Saturday, damaging its bow. Most of the more than 500 passengers aboard left quietly when the ship returned for repairs.

The 25 sit-downers, minus food and locked out of their cabins, camped in the promenade deck lounge and demanded assurances of passage on other ships.

### Beaverbrook Leaves Britain In Gloom, Sorrow

LONDON (Reuters)—Lord Beaverbrook, 75-year-old Canadian-born newspaper magnate and former cabinet minister, who leaves Thursday to spend the winter in Canada and the West Indies, said Tuesday night he was leaving Britain "in gloom and sorrow."

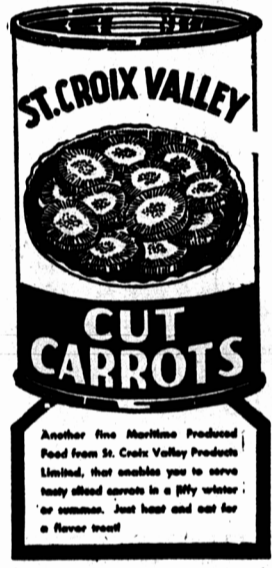
In a statement from the offices of The Daily Express, which he built up from a small newspaper to one of Britain's biggest dailies, he said:

"I am leaving for Canada and the West Indies where I will stay for the winter. Forty years ago I came in high hope and with great enthusiasm to help in the work for a united Empire."
