Cardigan Causeway Catch Has Surpassed All Others

The weather since the trout season opened has been cold with the wind in an off quarter for trout but record catches have become common place nevertheless. It is the consensus of opinion among the angling fraternity that the catch taken by Johnnie White at the Cardigan Causeway tops the list to date and, in all probability, will remain at the top for a long time. The Causeways were behind schedule as trout producers this season and it was wasted effort fishing them on the opening day. They reached the Vernon and North River Causeways five days late. Anglers report that angling at Vernon slackened off after the first few days and one has to do some exploring in the up-river area before contact is made.

North River Causeway is still a heavy trout producer. This week I counted 18 cars parked along the highway in mid afternoon with the majority of the anglers fishing from the bank. I was told they were having good luck too. I was told of one fisherman landing six trout, along with others in a lighter poundage bracket, that weighed over 3 pounds each. The big fellows patronize the sheltered cover formed by the long embankment that swarms with capelin, silver sides and gudgeon, etc. When this river was an ordinary tidal waterway such small fry had no other choice but to drift seaward or be stranded on the mud flats. Now they have a permanent home but their rental exists in run high water. I have had an extensive banquet table set for the full 24 hour stretch. A skin diver reported a couple of years ago that he saw schools of immense trout lasting away their time and ignoring the multitude of anglers off-fering. I have always maintained if we could see the big trout that examined our lures, and then turned away in disdain, we'd have an attack of high blood pressure.

IN GOOD CONDITION

The water keeps ice cold and trout in our ponds and dams are pretty sluggish to date but in remarkably good condition for so early in the season. Some are so torpid they don't care they are hooked till they are drawn to the top of the water. I made my first real tentative try for trout on the twenty - first and caught one... a twelve inch... that was full fleshed and flavoured but had about as much fight as a frog. On April 30th my yen for a feed of fried trout was not to be denied any longer. As I sat hunched in the boat a sou'east wind... consid-

ered by many anglers as being worse than one straight from the east... searched out every chink in my clothing and thought I was warmly clad when I left home.

I baited up with an enticing blob of worms and tossed the offering overboard. About five minutes passed before I felt a slight tug on the line. I was in no hurry to set the hook but when I did whatever was on the line let go. On my second cast I waited for several minutes after I became aware that something was experimenting with the bait and then put on the pressure. I knew I had something on but it felt like a waterlogged stick or branch. It was a trout and a nice one too but it didn't knock it was hooked until it reached the surface... just came along as gentle as a lamb.

GOT LIVELIER

I gave a few flops and sort of rolled on the surface. I thought I'd play with it for awhile, like I had with a mouse, but my quarry got livelier with the minute and finally took off in good style. It bored for the bottom and I had to give line. I thought I was in for trouble when it sagged the anchor rope but it did an about face and freed itself. I quit fooling around after that and headed my prize as quickly as possible. It was a well fleshed, highly coloured 13 inch crowding the one and a half pound mark. I hooked another, an exact replica of the first, minutes later. I was out for a fry, and it was too cold to prolong the chore of boating, so I didn't give this one time to wake up properly. When I caught 7... 3, thirteen inches and a 4 even 12 inches each. I dumped what worms I had left in the can overboard and paddled ashore.

I use bait when I want a trout fry and they refuse any other lure but I get no thrill out of the feel of a trout with a hook lodged in its stomach or gullet. Hook trout like that in late May or June on a light fly rod and you experience the thrill of a lifetime... they'll come close to wearing one down to a frazzle. You are never sure of them until you have them bottled. When using flies I make a lure of a fry and after that I release anything under 9 inches if they are not hurt. I have sold myself short before now when I let a few of my first caught trout go, and then they quit cold. Now I take no chances. Trout are so unpredictable. They'll start on a hitting spree at the drop of a hat and call it off just as quickly. I had to learn the hard way.

Rousseau Takes Calder Trophy

MONTREAL (CP) — Bobby Rousseau, a kid many tab as a future great with Montreal Canadiens, was named winner of the Calder Memorial Trophy Thursday night as the most proficient rookie in the National Hockey League last season. The honor carries a \$1,000 award from the league.

A pair of first-year men with Boston Bruins, Cliff Pennington and Pat Stapleton, were runners-up. But the 21-year-old Rousseau won easily, polling 141 of a possible 180 points. They were awarded on a 5-3-1 basis in voting by a panel of hockey writers and broadcasters from the six NHL cities.

LED FIRST HALF Rousseau, a five-foot-10 165-pounder who patrolled right-wing for the Habs was the leader in the first-half balloting. His edge over Pennington, a slick stickhandler, was narrow—53 to 51—at that point. Pennington, at 22 a year older than Bobby, finished 71 points behind.

Stapleton, a chunky little defenceman of 21, wound up with 41 points. Rousseau took part in all 70 of Montreal's scheduled games and scored 21 goals and 24 assists. He has good speed, a tricky shift and is among the hardest-shooting forwards in the league.
