

## Gun-Runners Business Is Booming In North Africa

RABAT, (Reuters) — International gun-runners are doing booming trade smuggling second world war weapons to anti-French rebels in Morocco and Algeria, French security officials say.

By camel caravan, night landings on the coast and by human pack train across arid mountains, the smugglers bring arms made in the United States, Britain, Spain and Italy. One rebel even was found with a Chinese pistol.

Less warlike supplies reaching Moroccan rebels are chewing gum and kif—a morale-boosting drug made from Indian hemp.

Some outlaws carry strychnine tablets for a quick death to avoid capture by French troops.

The hodge-podge assortment of arms and equipment is bolstering rebels on several fronts in Algeria and the Riff mountains of northern Morocco, where the rebellion now is in its fourth month.

Security measures were tightened around Taza Monday after a daring attack by rebels Sunday. A rebel force attacked a post held by Moroccan auxiliary policemen at a bridge, stole their weapons and kidnapped four of them.

HAS CAIRO ROOTS  
French officials claim the rebels are directed by the "committee for the liberation of North Africa" in Cairo. They say the committee is financed by various anti-colonialist groups in Cairo, by collections among Moslems abroad and in North Africa, and by "protection" money extorted from farmers in the rebel areas.

French intelligence reports say most of the arms have been coming from the Middle East and are channelled through distribution centres in Spanish Morocco and Libya. Most of the British arms date from the Second World War, in many cases the serial numbers are scratched out to hamper identification.

Rebels in western Algeria and the Riff mountains are supplied through Spanish Morocco with arms brought illegally by sea from the Middle East, the French say. The main consignment on this route is alleged to have come several months before the start of the Riff rebellion in October in a ship flying the Egyptian flag and carrying British officers.

## American Sets New Mark For 1,000 Metres

MELBOURNE (AP)—Lon Spurrier, American holder of the world half-mile record, shattered John Landy's Australian 1,000-metre record in a special race at Alympic Park Saturday.

Spurrier's time of 2:23.8 was 7.5 seconds better than the Australian mark held by Landy, world mile record holder, and was only 4.9 seconds outside the world 1,000-metre mark set by Hungary's Ivan Rozsavolgy and Norway's Aud Boyesen.

Australians Merv Lincoln and John Murray-second and third in the race — also bested Landy's time.
