A By-Law for Levying and Specifying the Rate of Assessment on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown for General Civic Purposes, under Statute 51 Victoria, Chapter 12.

BE it enacted by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows: 1st. The rate of assessment on Real Estate for general Civic purposes, under said Statute, for the year commencing the 1st day of January, A. D. 1892, and ending the 31st day of December, A. D. 1892, is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of ONE PER CENT on every dollar of the value of Real Estate as assessed by the Assessors of the said City of Charlottetown in the General Assessment Book and Valuation Roll of said Real Estate and Personal Property liable to taxation in said City, and of all persons liable to pay Poll Tax thereon, made and duly returned by them on the 4th day of May, A. D. 1892.

BE it enacted by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows: 1st. A Discount at the rate of TWO AND ONE HALF PER CENT shall be allowed to all Taxpayers who shall, on or before the 15th day of July next, A.
