## FOR THE WOMEN

How to Wash Your Face.

You laugh says an exchange, when you are asked, "Do you know how to wash your face?" But do you? Getting up in the morning and hurrying to get dressed, you throw some water over your face to take the sleep out of your eyes. You wipe it off and think it has had a bath. It has been ill-treated and neglected. This is the right way: Have a basin almost full of water with the chill taken off. Bathe your face with both hands, giving it such a bath that the water rolls down from it and the soft towel by which it is dried becomes absolutely wet with use. Dry it thoroughly—that is its morning bath. At night, just before you go to bed, bathe your face in hot water—that is, as hot as it will stand. Wash it with a flannel cloth on which has been rubbed a good soap. After the soap-suds have been removed finish with a bath of cold water, and you will find that with the simplest and best cosmetic, hot and cold water, your skin will whiten, your flesh will grow firmer and you will be yourself so much more comfortable that you will wonder why you were ever satisfied with what was really only a dab.

Strawberry Cream.—Place half an ounce of gelatine in half a cupful of cold water in a small bowl; when soft set the bowl in a pan of hot water on the stove, stir until dissolved. Mash one pint of well-cleaned strawberries with a silver fork, add half a cupful of sugar, the gelatine and a few drops of cochineal, set in a cool place stirring often; when it begins to thicken add half a pint of whipped cream, while stirring constantly; continue to stir a few minutes, then pour into a form and set on ice; serve either plain or with whipped cream.

After using a silver fork for fish—especially anything strong smelling, like herring—the odor often clings to the silver, even after washing. To prevent this, directly the fork has been used, wash it in warm water and then stand it in a basin of tea leaves for a few minutes.

### A Mother's Reward.

To Keep Brushes Clean.

The best way to clean hair brushes is with spirits of ammonia, as its effect is immediate. No rubbing is required, and cold or tepid water can be used as successfully as warm. Take a tablespoonful of ammonia to a quart of water, dip the bristles without wetting the back, and in a moment the grease is removed. Then rinse in cold water, shake well and dry in the air, but not in the sun. Soap and soda soften the bristles and do not get them so thoroughly clean.

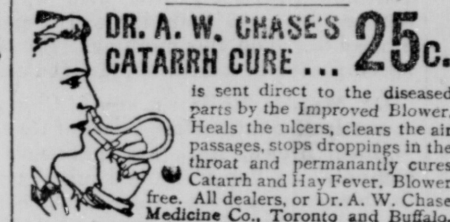
